The Malvern U3A Geology Group library is catalogued as an Excel Workbook, and an up-to-date searchable PDF version of each section is available on our group website. If you would like to have a paper copy of the catalogue, contact our library team (see below) or you can print the relevant sheet from the PDF.

The books, DVDs, maps, guides and booklets are available on loan to members of the group. A selection of the materials will be displayed at our indoor meetings. You can borrow them there, and return them at the next meeting in about one month's time. If you wish to look at or borrow a particular item from the catalogue, please get in touch with our librarian. Most of these materials are stored at The Malvern Cube. However, due to space restrictions, some of the books may be kept elsewhere. These can still be borrowed and are shown on the database with an asterisk (*) after the Library Reference number.

The Catalogue

There are four sections to the catalogue: Books, DVDs, Maps, Guides and Booklets.

You can view each full section by clicking on the relevant 'sheet tab' below.

Reduced-content printable sections that fit onto A4 landscape paper can be selected by clicking on the relevant print 'sheet tab' below.

Books are divided into the following categories:

- A Archaeology
- F Fossils and evolution
- G General geology
- H History of geology, biography, historical events
- L Local geology
- LF Landforms and landscape
- M Mapping
- MR Minerals and rocks
- OR Other regions (i.e. not local)

Levels of books: Level 1 - assuming little or no knowledge of geology. Level 2 - assuming some knowledge of geology or related sciences.

Both the categories and levels are shown on the label on the front of the book and in the catalogue.
